

Each Master Gardener Kit comes with two different sizes of nutrient packets to meet the needs of a variety of plant types.

The amount of nutrients in your AeroGarden increases with packet size. Each packet also contains ingredients that will keep the water in your garden at a pH level that is ideal for aeroponically grown plants.

Choose a Nutrient Regime

Most gardens will need a combination of small and large nutrient packets. If you are planting cuttings, you will not have to add nutrients until you see roots extend from the *Grow Sponges*. Since we don't know what's growing in your AeroGarden, we can only offer some guidelines for deciding which packets to use.

***“Small” Nutrient Packets = 4 ml packets for 3 -pod AeroGardens
8 ml packets for 6/7-pod AeroGardens***

Small nutrient packets should always be used when first planting seeds in your AeroGarden. See key above.

Leafy greens (such as lettuces), and woody herbs (such as oregano and thyme), grow best with “Small” nutrient packets (s) at each feeding for their entire life cycle.

For cuttings, start adding “Small” nutrients when you see roots extend from *Grow Sponges*. See key above.

***“Large” Nutrient Packets = 5.5 ml packets for 3-pod AeroGardens
5.5 ml packets x 2 for 6-pod and 7-pod AeroGarden
(add TWO 5.5 ml packets to equal a ‘Large’ feeding for 6/7-pods)***

Most plant types other than leafy greens and woody herbs need the higher amount of nutrients found in a “Large” nutrient packet after 4 weeks (the third feeding). Mint, basil and parsley are examples of herbs that grow well with “Large” nutrient packet(s) at each feeding for the remainder of their life cycle.

TWENTY-SEVEN (27) 8 ml packets
FORTY-EIGHT (48) 5.5 ml packets
